ORDINANCE 1083

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH BRADDOCK, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 970 BY REVISING SECTION II TITLED DEFINITIONS AND ADDING A NEW PARAGRAPH TO SECTION V TITLED STANDARDS AND REGULATIONS FOR COLLECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough Council of North Braddock, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 970 regulates the storage, collection and disposal of rubbish, refuse, and garbage in the municipality; and

WHEREAS, additional regulations are required regulating the collection and disposal of Bulky Waste;

NOW THEREFORE, the Borough of North Braddock, Pennsylvania hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: SECTION II of Ordinance No. 970 titled Definitions is amended by deleting the existing definition of Bulky Waste and replacing it with the following definition of Bulky Waste:

Bulky Waste - means solid waste items that are too large to fit in a closed thirty-five (35) gallon container or plastic bag or more than three bundles containing branches, bushes, stumps or other cuttings of vegetative matter in a length and width greater than three (3) feet and stoves, refrigerators, dishwashers, washing machines, dryers, sofas, stuffed chairs, mattresses, box springs, auto parts and construction debris and any individual bag, bundle or item weighing more than seventy-five pounds or which cannot be loaded into a normal refuse collection truck by one person because of its size.

SECTION 2: Section V of Ordinance No. 970 titled Standards and Regulations for Collection is amended by adding a new paragraph 9 as follows:

9. Owners of residential property whether owner occupied or rented are responsible for scheduling and liable for paying for the collection of Bulky Waste as herein defined. Three days notice to the Borough Code Enforcement Office or the North Braddock Police Department that a Bulky Waste collection is scheduled, the date and the


location of the collection and the name and address and phone number of the waste hauler.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


